He served as the Assistant Commander in charge of interviews/interrogations, and also acted as the liaison to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, & Firearms Polygraph Division. Mr. DeLeo has conducted several thousand interviews which have resulted in numerous confessions and convictions. His dynamic interrogation skills are highly respected and admired by even the most seasoned Fire/Arson Investigators. He is recognized by the Illinois State Fire Marshal as an Arson Investigator and is a member of the International Association of Arson Investigators. Mr. DeLeo is passionate about his craft and has been teaching interviewing and interrogation classes throughout the State of Illinois. He has instructed for the Nevada Chapter of the I.A.A.I and is currently a faculty member of the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn, Illinois.
